Endnote 1 This test is intended to identify IgG antibodies implicated in hemolytic diseases of the newborn. It does not routinely detect IgM antibodies and thus is not suitable for screening for irregular antibodies prior to transfusion.

This assay is a screening test for the detection of red blood cell antibodies. The test is not to be used for pretransfusion screening or for the medical management of an alloimmunized pregnancy.
