Seroconversion demonstrated by a 4-fold or greater increase in IgG titer or a single IgG titer of > or = 1:128 is considered presumptive laboratory evidence of current or past infection. Antibodies may persist for months to years after clearance of infection. Serologic cross reactivity between closely related organisms, such as Anaplasma species, can occur.
