This assay detects antibodies against recombinant Sin Nombre virus (Hantavirus) antigen.

The immune response to Hantavirus infection is not species-specific, and thus cross-reactivity between Hantaviruses can occur. IgM positive may suggest acute infection, while IgG positivity may indicate past or current infection. Results should be interpreted in the context of pertinent clinical and physical findings.
