No laboratory evidence of infection with *B. burgdorferi* (Lyme Disease).

Screening and/or supplemental tests for Lyme disease antibodies may be falsely negative in early stages of Lyme disease, including the period when erythema migrans is apparent. If recent infection is suspected, repeat testing on a new sample collected in 7-14 days is recommended.
